## IN GIVING, WE RECEIVE

**De-addiction and Cancer Screening Camp** for MCGM sanitation workers, in our own backyard; G-South ward. These are the invisible heroes who keep our surroundings clean. They were screened for oral, breast and cervical cancer along with free eye checkup, dental checkup, hemoglobin, blood sugar, blood pressure amongst others. In addition, medicines were dispensed such as deworming, iron, calcium, multivitamins and nicotine replacement lozenges.

Total beneficiaries recorded were 622 in number, 422 being males and 189 females. For more than 50 percent of the beneficiaries abnormal findings were recorded, consequent to which they will be referred for free or subsidized, treatment, medication or surgery as needed.

This was a joint project between Rotary Club for Addiction Prevention & Rotary Club of Mumbai SOBO with the volunteer support by the Rotaract Club of , Rotaract Club of Caduceus and Rotaract Club of Medicrew.

15 final teams pitched to the 4 whales namely Ms. Natasha Raj, Head HR HDFC Credila Financial Services Ltd. Mr. Sapan Choksi, CEO Systems Plus Solutions; Mr. Chetan Mehra, Vice Chairman Weizmann Ltd and Mr. Pradeep Gopalkrishnan, MD and Chief Risk Officer Deutsche Bank AG India. 7 projects ultimately obtained firm financial commitments from them. Other Activities for the Month

- 1. 4 Children successfully operated at SRCC hospital under the **Global Grant for Pediatric Heart Surgeries** Sponsored by our club along with our international sponsor The Rotary Club of Marbella-Guadalmina for facilitating carrying out of 100+ Pediatric Heart Surgeries.
- 2. 502 beneficiaries at a cost of Rs. 29,618 under the Digital Learning App Distribution Project; that aims to provide a Digital Learning App to 10th grade students in municipal schools free of cost. Rotary SOBO is the lead club for this project in District 3141
- . 103 direct beneficiaries of the CPR training for the residents of Lodha Park and Lodha World in association with the Rotary Club of Amara Thane
- 4. Support extended to Om Creations, (an organization which aims to empower mentally challenged people through developing vocational skills). For exhibition and sale of their products at our own Club Assembly and at the Grand Hyatt







The **CS R/TRF Committee** successfully introduced the 'Whale Tank Project' as a platform to help the Rotary clubs in District 3141 engage with the CSR Community where a funding of Rs. 1 cr. was committed towards 7 shortlisted beneficiaries. At the monthly meeting members deliberated on the progress of the Kala Ghoda Art Project, and the service project to contribute and provide assistance to AURED (an organization dedicated to enabling children with hearing loss to listen and speak), whilst also planning a Black- Tie dinner event for raising funds and discussing and penning down the overall targets for TRF.

The **Monthly Visit to the Door Step School**, where we distribute mid-day meals and fruits to 160 children twice a week, throughout the year was carried out. A new initiative was taken up this month to conduct a series of workshops on Skill Development and Wellbeing. The first workshop "*Manifestation and Love for Self*", was conducted by Rtn Hirral Merchant. This workshop comprised activities designed for children to know their true self through the aid of drawings and props. A heartfelt and overwhelming response was received from children of DSS at Crawford and Wadibunder. Additionally, Rtn. Sunay ana Vora donated 200 packets of Oreo biscuits and 200 caps to the DSS children this month. Occasional treats incentivize the children to continue attending school. These really made their day!

The **Environment Committee Month Meet** saw the Founder and CEO of RUR Green Life Pvt Ltd, Ms. Monisha Narke present crisp and clear ideas to participate for improving our environment. A three pronged action plan will be developed and implemented including a site visit to a gated community in our area where the company has installed waste management systems, a drive for the collection of discarded tetra packs to be deposited in one of the 54 locations serviced by the company in South Mumbai and creation of an awareness program.

Also, Rtn Rajesh Choudhary from the Rotary Club of Mumbai Versova introduced the Alpha Rotary Forest a project led by the Rotary Club of Mumbai Versova and the Rotary Club of Palghar for afforestation of 34 acre land planting around 20,000 native trees.
